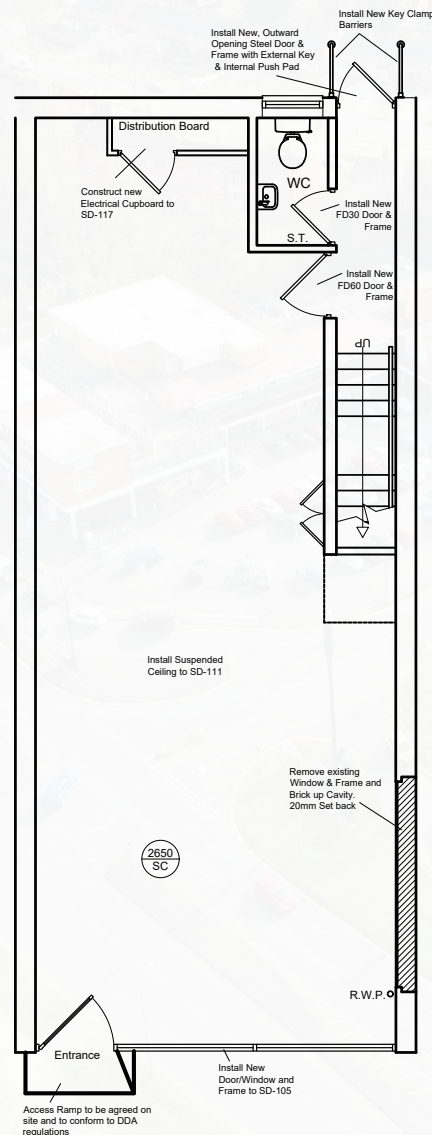

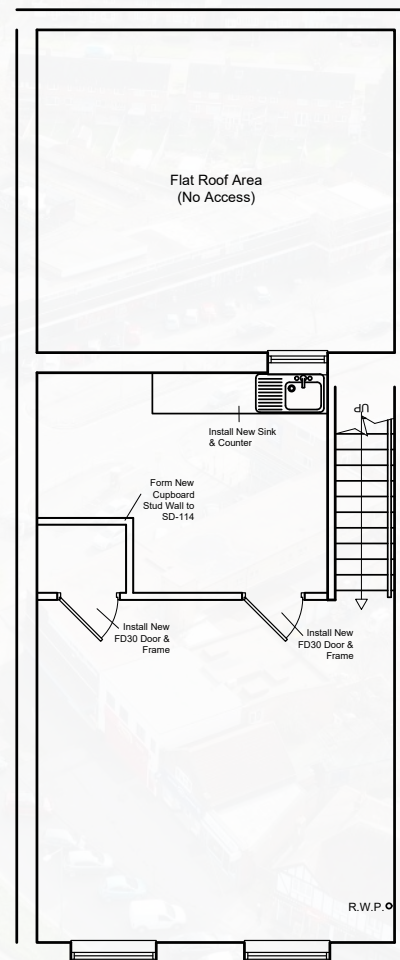

DESCRIPTION

Units with ground floor retail sales area, located in a busy parade and part of Market Square, Royton Shopping Centre. The units participate in a service charge and insurance scheme. Energy performance certificates are available on request.

LOCATION

The main A571 Rochdale Road runs through the centre of the town forming the main street before continuing northwards to Rochdale. The M62 runs to the north and is accessed via the A663 at junctions 21 and 20 via the A627 (M) from Royton.
